**American Legion Baseball** is a national institution and enjoys a reputation as one of the most successful and tradition-rich amateur athletic leagues. Today, the program registers over 5,400 teams in all 50 states, Canada and Puerto Rico. Almost 100,000 youths, ages 15 to 19, participate annually. **Nearly 60 percent of current college players are program graduates.**

**Boys/Girl State** - is an educational program sponsored by the American Legion to help young men and women learn about government and how it works. The Boys/Girls State facilitates the learning process by giving the citizens of Boys/Girls State an opportunity to govern themselves, and to run their own state.

**Student Trooper** - In partnership with the Michigan State Police, this program will teach young men and women about a career in law enforcement. 4 College Scholarships Awarded to Attendees That Range From \$500 to \$1000

**Boy Scouts** - a program supported since 1919. Today, Legion posts sponsor more than 2,500 Boy Scouting units across the country. Few other post activities generate more goodwill from the community. The Legion annually honors the Eagle Scout of the Year at the national convention.

**Oratorical Contest** - program is to provide high school students with a deeper understanding of the Constitution of the United States, develop and sharpen their speaking skills, and compete for scholarship money ranging from \$800 - \$1,500 (Department Contest) and \$14,000 - \$18,000 (National Contest)

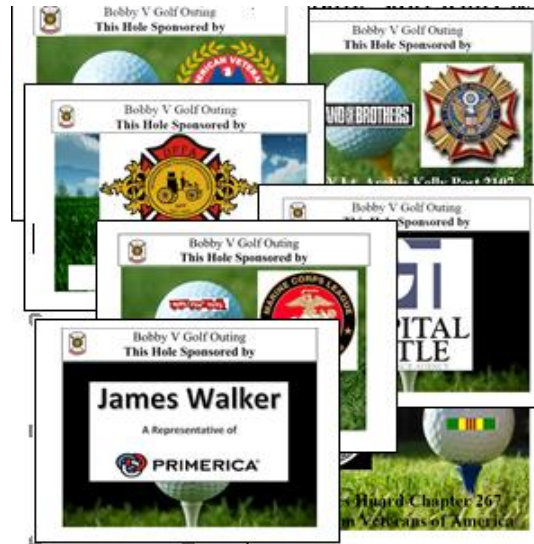
